Community Advisory: Indecent Exposure Incident

Date: March 31, 2026

Location: University Extension, Building B (231 Social Sciences Quad)

Details:

UCIPD is investigating an indecent exposure incident that occurred on Tuesday, March 31, 2026 at approximately 3:20 p.m. The reporting party shared that a male approached them and asked to fill out a survey. As the reporting party was filling out the survey, the male suspect dropped his pants and exposed their genitalia. The reporting party described the suspect as a black male, taller than 5'7", had a beard, wearing a black hat, white shirt, black pants, wearing a necklace and called himself "Jara".

A second reporting party shared that a black male, approximately 20-30 years old, wearing a white shirt and black pants attempted to get them into a room in Building B as well, but the reporting party refused and walked away. UCIPD canvassed the area but was unable to locate any subjects matching the descriptions provided by the reporting parties.
