BURGLARY

UCI Police Department is investigating a third burglary that occurred last week at a Vista Del Campo apartment between Friday, April 14 at 8:10 p.m. and Sunday, April 16 at 1:40 p.m. Unknown suspect(s) gained access to the apartment by breaking the patio window. Once inside, the suspect(s) stole the residents' property from inside a hallway closet. They also forced entry into a bedroom and stole multiple items.
