Subject: Crime Alert: Stolen Vehicles

Location: UCI East Parking Structure and second floor balcony of Aldrich Hall.

UCI Police Department received reports of a stolen car and an electric golf cart. A black Acura RSX Type-S was taken from the East Parking Structure between 3/12/18 at about 8:18am and 3/14/18 at about 7:45am and was subsequently found on 3/19/18 by LAPD stripped of its transmission, engine, and car seats.

On 3/19/18 it was reported that an unknown suspect took an electric motorized cart, Club Car Villager 6, belonging to UCI Irvine Admissions between 03/15/08 at approximately 7pm and 03/19/2018 at approximately 8:30am.

Although we believe these two incidents are unrelated, we are compelled to notify the UCI community due to the Clery Act. Should you have information that could be helpful to these investigations, please contact UCI Police Department at 949-824-5223.

Never leave purses, wallets, electronics or other valuables in plain sight.
